Data Submission Deadlines

Reminder!

The **submission deadline** for reporting **Quarter 2 2023** (April 1—June 30, 2023) clinical data for *Median Time from ED Arrival to ED Departure for Discharged ED Patients*, and *Head CT or MRI Scan Results for Acute Ischemic Stroke or Hemorrhagic Stroke Patients who Received Head CT or MRI Scan Interpretation Within 45 Minutes of ED Arrival* measures into the Hospital Quality Reporting (HQR) system is **November 1, 2023, 11:59 p.m. Pacific Time (PT)**. Submission of Hospital OQR Program Population and Sampling data is voluntary.

The **submission deadline** for reporting **Quarter 2 2023** (April 1—June 30, 2023) *COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Among Healthcare Personnel (HCP)* data into the National Healthcare Safety Network (NHSN) system is **November 15, 2023, 11:59 p.m. PT**.

Abstraction Spotlight: ED Departure Time

Scenario: The emergency department (ED) Progress Note states that the patient was medically cleared and discharged into police custody on 05/30/2023 at 0605. The ED Nursing Assessment Note states: "ED Discharge To: Discharge 05/30/2023 at 0605."

There is a Face Sheet with an ED Discharge Date and Time of 05/30/2023 at 0800.

The ED Discharge Date and Time within the visit also has documentation in the Patient Information section stating a discharge date and time of 05/30/2023 at 0800; this is also listed in the header of the Electronic Health Record (EHR) encounter.

Question: In this scenario, which time should be abstracted for the *ED Departure Time* data element given that there are multiple discharge times associated with the patients across various ED record types, including Notes stating the time as 0605, but also a Face Sheet and EHR listing the time as 0800?

Answer: The [Hospital OQR Specifications Manual](#) states to **use the latest documented departure time** when more than one departure or discharge time is documented in the medical record. The manual also states the medical record must be abstracted as documented (taken at "face value").

In this scenario, the medical record Face Sheet has an ED Discharge Date and Time of 05/30/2023 at 0800, with additional surrounding documentation to support abstracting 0800 for *ED Discharge Time*. The 0800 time is the latest documented ED departure time from acceptable sources in the medical record.
