**Prospective Payment System (PPS)-Exempt Cancer Hospital (PCH) Facility-Specific Reports (FSRs) for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 Program Year Now Available**

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is providing facilities with FSRs containing information on the following two measures for program year FY 2025.

Measure	Performance Period
PCH-30/PCH-31: <i>Admissions and Emergency Department (ED) Visits for Patients Receiving Outpatient Chemotherapy</i> (chemotherapy measure)	July 1, 2022–June 30, 2023
PCH-37: <i>Surgical Treatment for Localized Prostate Cancer</i> (prostate cancer measure)	July 1, 2021–June 30, 2022

The FSR is a Microsoft Excel workbook containing facility performance results, national results, and detailed patient-level data used to calculate the measure results. The FSRs provide facilities with an opportunity to review their results and understand their performance on the measures prior to public reporting in summer 2024 and are accompanied by a user guide to help facilities interpret their FSR.

CMS is also providing facilities with confidential results on the CMS disparity methods for the chemotherapy measure. These results are being provided confidentially only and will not be publicly reported in 2024.
